



In-House Imaging Technician Opening

This is a full-time position that requires candidates to have a minimum of two years horse handling experience, other than your own personal horses. Experience with thoroughbreds or standardbreds preferred. The hours are daytime, generally Monday through Friday with some overtime required. The ability to self-start and work independently, as well as work well with others is a must. Must be capable of lifting 50-75 lbs. consistently as well as standing for long periods of time.

Primary Job duties include but are not limited to:

- Perform CT, MRI, PET, and nuclear scintigraphy scans independently under the supervision of Dr. Garrett while observing all proper procedures
- Have knowledge of CT, MRI, PET, and nuclear scintigraphy equipment, workflow, and be able to troubleshoot common problems
- Communicate with service engineers for CT, MRI, PET, and nuclear scintigraphy for both routine service and unexpected problems, perform routine maintenance and quality control on CT, MRI, PET, and nuclear scintigraphy equipment
 - Stock and clean CT, MRI, and scintigraphy rooms
 - Work effectively and collegially with other members of the imaging team
 - Provide coverage for Dr. Garrett's clinician technician when they are out of town
 - Understand and utilize EzyVet/VetRocket for imaging patients and imaging needs

Secondary duties

- To be performed after primary duties are complete
 - Assist teams with ultrasounds, radiographs, lameness exams, pre-operative workup, and other procedures in radiology
 - Assist with stocking and cleaning radiology area
- Compensation based on previous experience.
