- Oversee the health and well-being of all animals. This includes scheduling visits by veterinarians and other health care professionals. Keep appropriate records on all animal care and research activity.
- Maintain the appearance and functional capabilities of animal research facilities. Maintain an adequate supply of all feed, bedding, equipment and health supplies. Manage all waste and litter disposal for animal facilities.
- Assure animal care meets or exceed standards set by the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee as outlined in IACUC-approved standard operating procedures.
- Communicate openly and effectively with research managers regarding animal health, care and research efforts.
- Maintain appropriate written records as required by the research managers and IACUC.
- Assist in tours and other Alltech sponsored events.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in Animal Science or a closely related scientific field, or equivalent experience in animal care and management.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Strong attention to detail and the ability to follow written and verbal instructions.
