

Briar Hill Stables Groom Position

Backup groom needed for this weekend and future weekend coverage for when the current groom is unavailable. **Please email hannah.gabbard@enrollmentbuilders.com if interested in this position.**

Weekend coverage for this weekend 8/26 - 8/28

- Horse care coverage needed for one horse and one miniature horse.
- Turn out, muck stalls, feed, water, and grooming.
- AM coverage: 15-20 minutes in the morning spent bringing in, feeding, and mucking stalls.
- PM coverage: Around 2 hours: prepping hay, muck stalls, feed, water, groom, turnout.

Future coverage:

- Weekend availability needed for when owners and other groom are unavailable.
- Groom is responsible for daily tasks such as mucking out stalls, feed preparation and distribution, cleaning and refilling water containers, grooming and bathing, cleaning tack, bandaging legs, tacking up, and administering basic first aid for cuts and scrapes.
- In addition, groom will be required to handle horses of all temperaments; accurately and correctly apply blankets, sheets and boots according to owner's requirements. Accurately mix and dispense medications, including the use of a dosing syringe.
- Groom will hold horses for treatment by the farrier and veterinarian, assist with preparations for shipping horses to shows or races, and operate various pieces of farm equipment.
- The groom is expected to report back to owner when noticing any injuries, changes in behavior, or potential hazards.
- As with most horse farm work, this position requires heavy lifting, bending, climbing, twisting, pushing, pulling, reaching above the shoulders, walking on uneven and/or slippery terrain and other physical stresses; as well as exposure to extreme heat and cold, sun, dust, hay and other common allergens. This position includes outside work in all weather conditions. Must have reliable transportation regardless of weather conditions.
